- The video documentary will be the views of AIFO program beneficiaries, Implementing Partners, government officials and key program staff of AIFO-Liberia
- AIFO Communications team will work closely with the selected Media Consultant to travel to the counties and guide the process with technical aspects of AIFO programs and projects.

- First draft video after edit should be ready and turned in by March 15
- Second draft video after edit should be ready and turned in by March 18
- Final video after edit should be ready and turned in by March 25

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The Media Consultant will be accompanied by AIFO Communications Team in the
 counties for the purpose of recording video and shots as well as writing news stories
 and documentary as spelt out in the objective, ensuring that content is well-edited,
 documented and ready to be shared.
- Develop the documentary film's overall concept and scenario;
- Interview selected beneficiaries for the film who will include actual beneficiaries, local government officials, Implementing Partners and key program staff of AIFO-Liberia;
- Visit and interact with the local communities who've been impacted by the AIFO's programs to get context.
- Develop the documentary script and storyboard to be used in the recording.



- Perform appropriate video filming and shoot interviews with the major beneficiaries and stakeholders.
- Present two draft video documentary to AIFO-Liberia Liberia Communications Team for review and validation
- Produce and present a FINAL documentary video and a promotional preview
